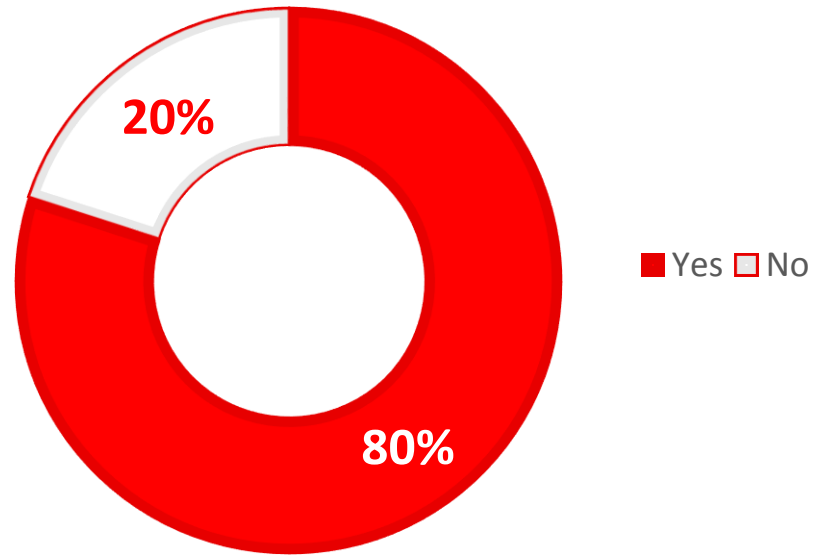

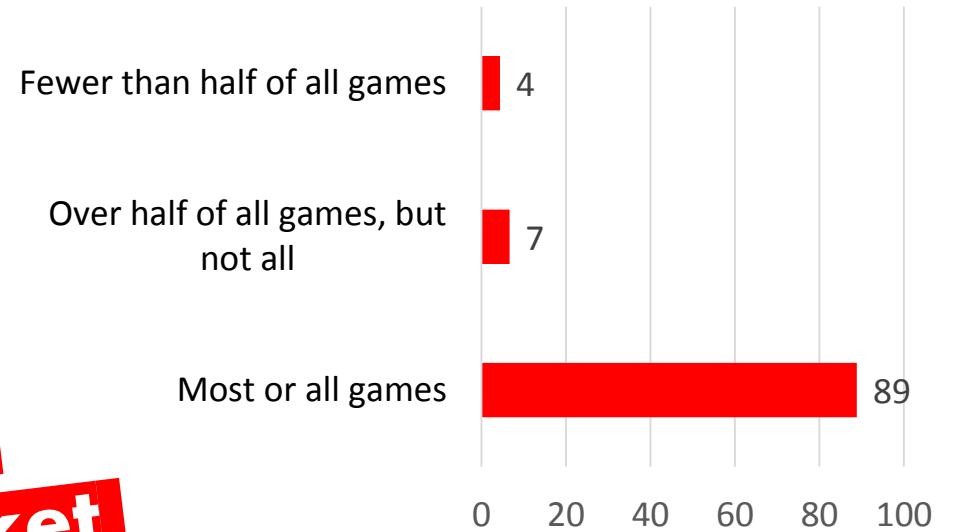
Do you have a season ticket for Rotherham United home matches?



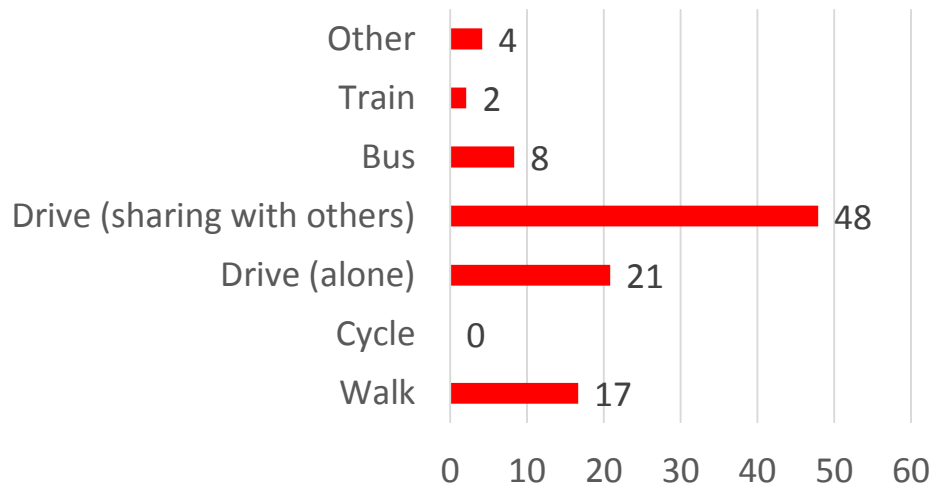
80% of respondents have a Rotherham United season ticket

How many Rotherham United home matches do you attend in an average season?

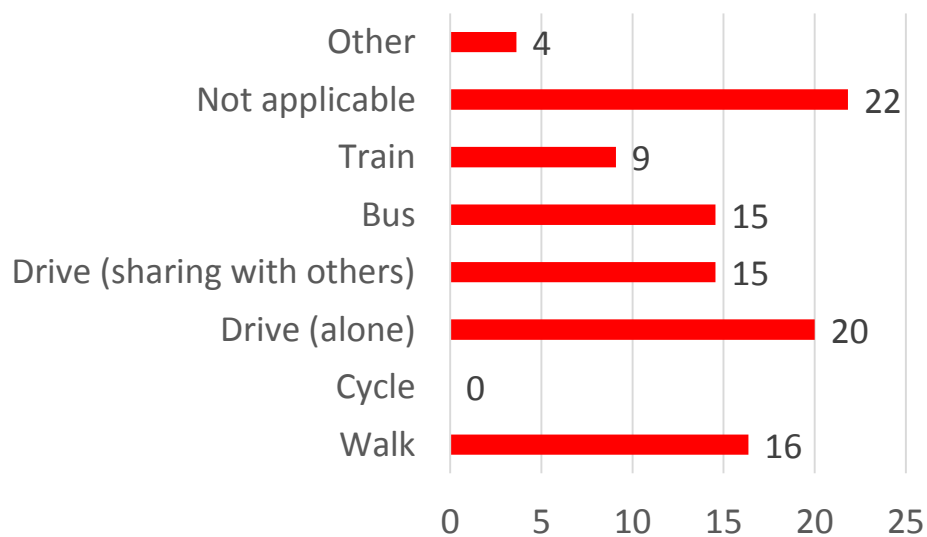


What is your usual method of transport to Rotherham United home matches?



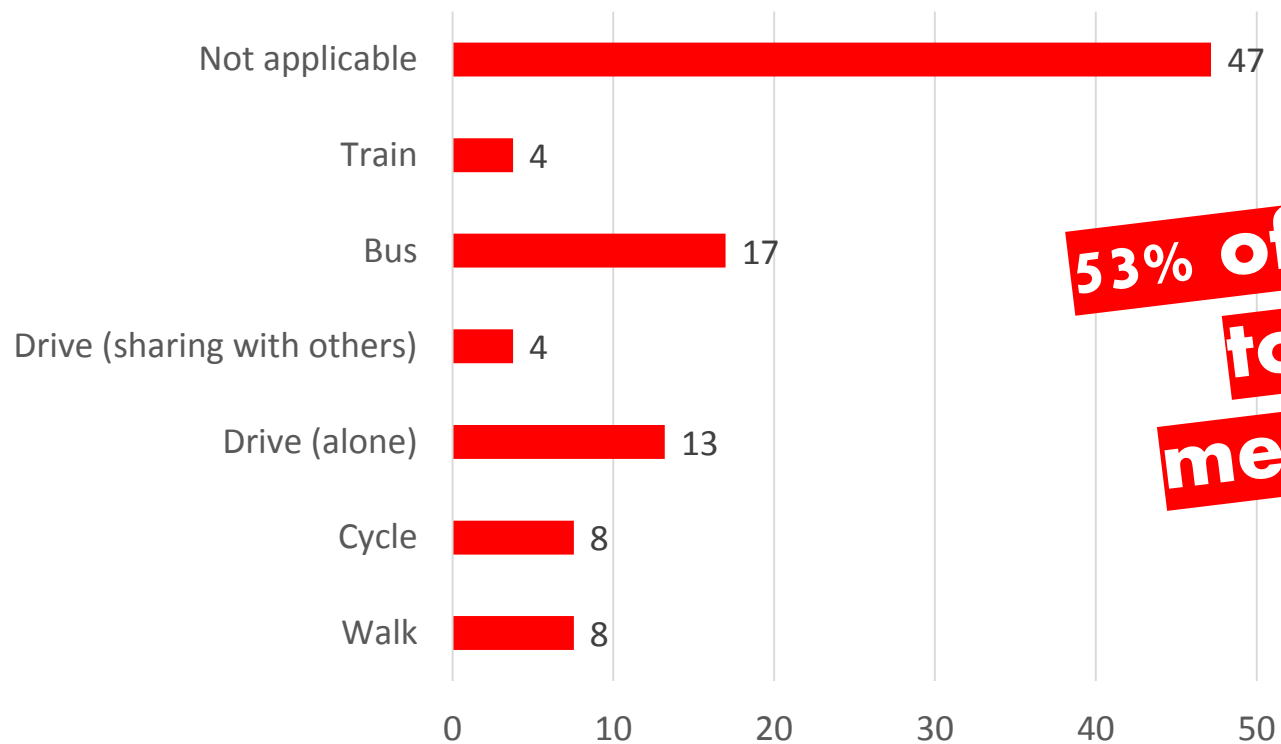
69% of respondents use a car to get to the match either alone (21%) or with others (48%)

What do you think Rotherham United could do to make it easier for fans to get to the AESSEAL New York Stadium without a car?

'What some Rotherham supporters said'

Only thing would be a bridge behind the family stand over to the car park on Westgate.

Direct bus links.

Needs a new footbridge over the river to get away from the stadium better. Back of family stand straight across to where the car parks are would make a massive improvement.

Include a public transport bus travel in a certain radius with match ticket

I travel by car as I am disabled but more parking for disabled supporters near or in the ground area would be helpful.

Liaise with public transport services to provide buses from outlying areas

Consider possibility to operate discounted rail travel for supporters with season tickets.

I don't live locally (Worksop), so doesn't apply to me, but I would suggest reduced/concessionary rates on public transport might help.

Secure Cycle Parking.

Bigger car park at stadium for home fans.

What do you think Rotherham United could do to make it easier for fans to get to the AESSEAL New York Stadium without a car?

'What some Rotherham supporters said'

A better bus service could operate from the ground instead of people having to walk to main bus station.

Buses from different areas.

Let the local authority know when the games are scheduled so that they can suspend road works in and around Rotherham, thus easing congestion and long queues on the main arterial routes.

Cheap, regular public transport.

Run special busses from outlying areas via nearer areas to the AESSEAL New York Stadium.

Safe cycle parking bays.

Buses from areas with large number of fans, Kimberworth, Maltby, Thurcroft etc (free).

Bus that stops at the ground.

Unfortunately I live close to Bawtry, there is no alternative for me to get to the ground.

Discounted Bus Tickets and designated bus routes on match day with "stop" near to ground. Nearest for me (Bramley, Rotherham) is to walk from bus station to AESSEAL NYS.

Cheaper Tickets.

What do you think other organisations, such as bus or train companies or the local council, could do to make it easier for fans to get to AESSEAL New York Stadium without a car?

'What some Rotherham supporters said'

Free bus from outlying areas.

Nothing, walking is the most practical.

Why are cars being singled out, what about electric vehicle charging points?

Have a bus service from the ground.

Regular services at appropriate times.

Put free buses on and create some park and ride sites.

Not sure. Seems to me that the bus and train stations are near enough to NYS for an easy walk.

Cheap, regular public transport.

Extra busses round match times.

Adjust timetables to tie in with match finish times.

Special free bus for people with walking difficulties from the bus station.

Subsidise the cost.

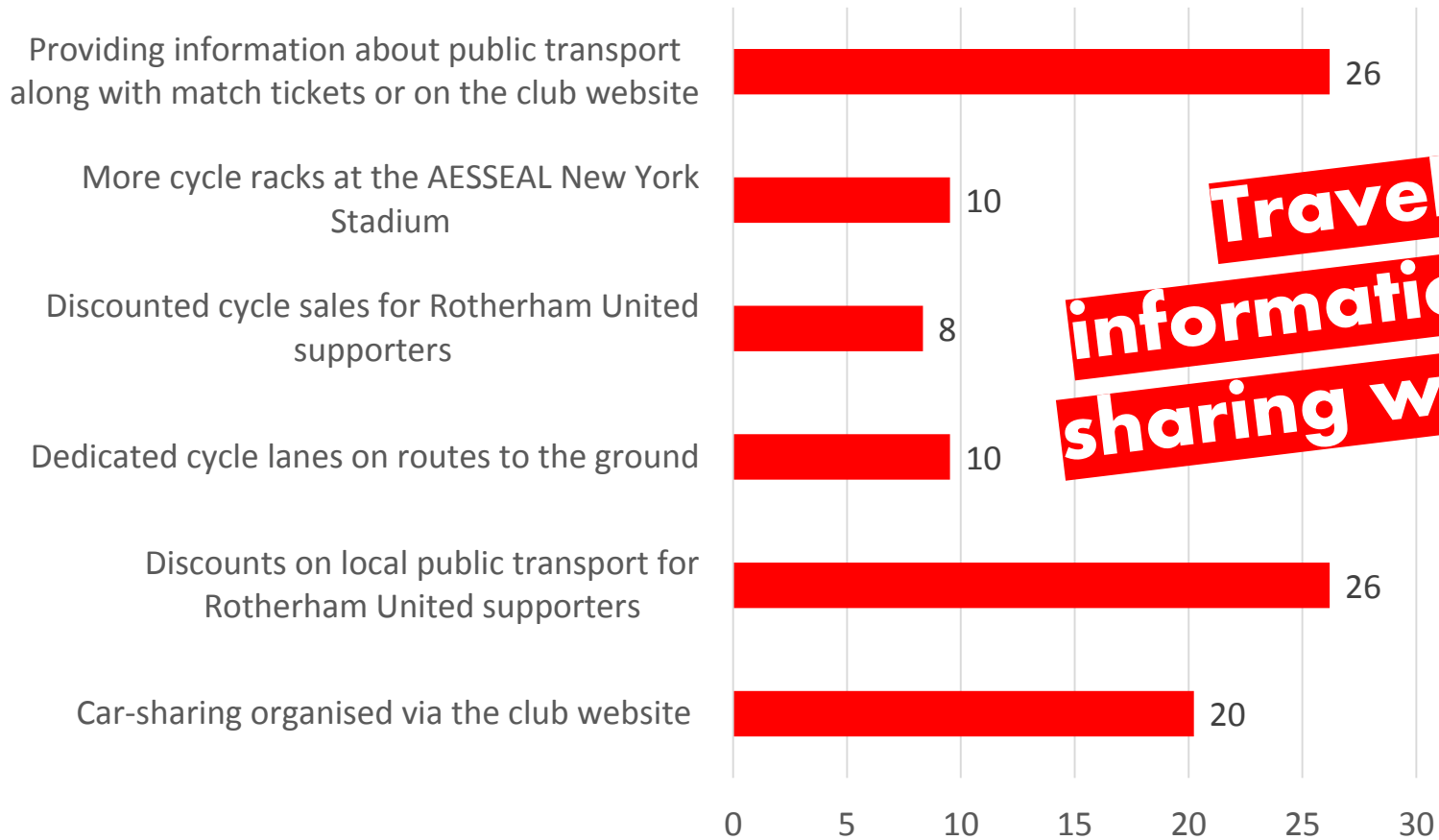
Reduce fares.

Cheaper Tickets.



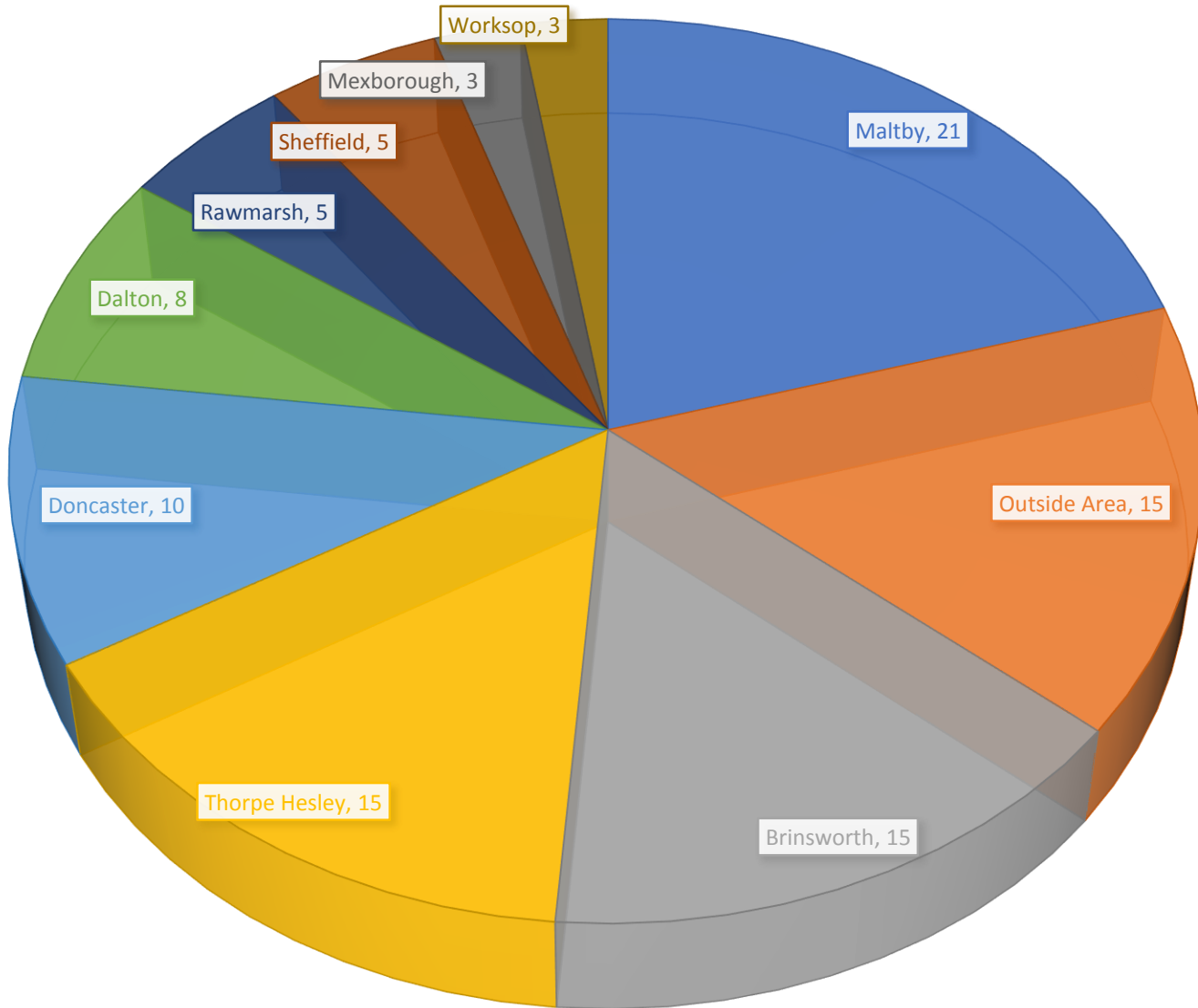
